

What is CPF?

The CPF, Cadastro de Pessoas Físicas – CPF, is an official document used to register a citizen, brazilian or not, in the Receita Federal do Brasil database.

It is not mandatory but without it, you cannot have a bank account, a mobile chip or make certain financial transactions or purchases.

Besides the protocol or its number, you should take the original document that you used to register: your passport, RNM (or its protocol).
